NM 176 Pavement Rehabilitation Work begins this week in Lea County

The New Mexico Department of Transportation (NMDOT) District Two began a pavement rehabilitation project this week on a section of NM 176 in Lea County. The project includes 10 miles of pavement rehabilitation and shoulder widening from mile marker 0 to mile marker 10. The work will cost approximately \$9 million and is expected to be complete summer 2017.

During the project, motorists can expect lane restrictions and temporary lane closures. Motorists are encouraged to use caution while driving through the work zone.
