

Attorney Jason Waechter Offers Winter Driving Tips

A major snowstorm is predicted to hit the northeastern United States this weekend, bringing an estimated 20 inches of snow, high winds, and terrible road conditions. In light of these predictions, Auto Accident Attorney Jason Waechter is offering his best winter driving tips to try to reduce crashes, injuries, and deaths during and after the storm.

While some predictions for this major storm vary depending upon the source, most of them [agree](#) on two key points: a lot of snow – up to twenty inches in some areas – along with high winds. There is also a possibility of freezing rain, cold temperatures, power outages, and even flooding in some areas.

“My most important tip: the best way to reduce roadway crashes, injuries, and deaths in weather like they are predicting is to simply stay off the roads,” advises Waechter. “Plan ahead so that once the storm starts, you can stay home and leave the roads open to emergency vehicles and snow plows.”

For drivers who can’t stay home, Waechter and his team have compiled a list of winter driving tips. The list includes preparation tips, such as topping up windshield washer fluid and gas before a storm. Waechter’s list also suggests keeping an emergency kit, including water and snacks, a blanket, warm clothing, a first-aid kit, and a small shovel (among other things), in the car at all times.

Other contributions to the list include always driving with headlights on, and leaving extra space between yourself and the car in front of you when the temperature goes below freezing. The complete list of winter driving tips is available on Waechter’s [blog](#).

“Obviously, following our winter driving tips are not a guarantee that you will avoid a crash,” says Waechter. “No matter how prepared or careful you are, if you’re on the road in poor conditions, there’s a chance an accident could happen. Stay safe, and if you can, stay home,” he concludes.
