- Keeping an eye out for inattentive or distracted drivers vehicles coming from the rear when stopped at an intersection.
- Look for an escape route at intersections to avoid a collision from the rear.

• Maintain a 2-second safety advantage by scanning all your mirrors and side windows all the time. The lesson concludes with this advice:

"Rearview mirrors, appropriate head movement, and active visual scanning of the road environment: use them all to your maximum advantage as defensive driving techniques to reduce the likelihood of side and rear collisions. The life you save may be your own!"
