The system keeps a child from being left in a vehicle unattended on a hot day, which is designed to reduce the risk of death from hyperthermia. It offers added peace of mind to parents and caregivers. The invention features automatic operation. Furthermore, it is adaptable for use with any new or existing vehicle.
