In 2014, Arizona's DUI task force which included an estimated 1,800 police officers, made a total of 495 DUI arrests over Memorial Day weekend. Officers also gave out more than 1,850 speeding citations and approximately 342 seat belt citations, according to Phoenix New Times.

"Police officers know there will be a steep increase in drivers on the road over Memorial Day weekend," said Christopher Corso, founder of Corso Law Group. "It's likely we'll see an increase in DUI patrols and overall arrests."

An Arizona DUI can have severe consequences including jail time in tent city, thousands of dollars in fines, increased auto insurance and the requirement of an interlock device.
