



## Classics and Kustoms to be Featured at 2005 Glenmoor Gathering

There will also be a display of memorable Kustoms vintage custom cars built in the 1940s, 50s and 60s, including vintage customs such as The Polynesian.

We've already located several of these legendary custom cars and hot rods and we'd like to find more, said the event's executive director, David Schultz. Our goal is to present the best.

In addition to the Classics and Kustoms, a variety of antique motor cars, sports cars and motorcycles domestic and foreign will be on display during the Sunday concours.

The weekend's activities begin on Friday with a golf tournament on Glenmoor Country Club's Jack Nicklaus Signature 72-hole golf course. A kick-off welcome party will be held Friday evening on the Glenmoor CC patio.

On Saturday morning, prior to the start of the Grand Classic, the countryside tour (for car show participants and their vehicles only) will depart the club. That evening, a gala dinner will be held, preceded by a cocktail party and charity auction on the lawns of Glenmoor Country Club. The automotive art tent will be open Saturday evening and all day Sunday.

In addition to Sunday's concours event on the rear lawns of Glenmoor, a large group of British sports cars and CCCA Classics will be displayed on the club's front lawn.

All of the events except the Saturday morning countryside tour are open to the public...
