• Remember that if you have one drink and someone else hits you, you may be found liable for any injuries and damages even if the accident isn't your fault — it just isn't worth it.

• You may consider staying home with your family and not being out on the roads at all — even if you aren't drinking and driving, other drivers on the road may be intoxicated and unsafe.

• If you are out on the roads, pay extra attention to other drivers around you and keep a safe distance between you and the car ahead — just because you haven't been drinking and driving doesn't mean the driver next to you made the same choice.
