Pittsburgh-based InventHelp is submitting the ATD AUTO TRASH DISPENSER to companies in the hopes of a good faith review.

"I was tired of littering like this, and we had no garbage bag in the car. This led me to develop a waste-disposal system for vehicles."

He developed the ATD AUTO TRASH DISPENSER to offer a convenient way to dispose of trash while driving, including leftover food and liquids. This keeps the vehicle interior neat and clean, and makes travel conditions more enjoyable for the driver and passengers. The system eliminates the need to throw trash out the window, which is designed to reduce littering, keeping roads and highways clean. Additionally, it is adaptable for use with any vehicle.
