The DOUBLE DUTY SHIELD A WHEEL facilitates detailing a vehicle's tires. It protects a wheel rim from overspray, which prevents stains, as well as saves time and effort. The unit secures over the wheel rim via magnetism. The shield is ideal for car detailers and DIYers.
