Cigar smokers tend to have difficulty storing lit cigars while driving due to the size of a cigar, which has the potential to ultimately interfere with vehicle safety.

An avid cigar smoker from Wilson, N.C., has invented the patent-pending TWEEDS, a portable cigar ashtray that can be easily implemented into a vehicle. TWEEDS allows drivers to easily store a lit cigar, allowing them to fully concentrate on traffic, improving driver safety. Additionally, TWEEDS helps to maintain the integrity of a vehicle's interior by reducing the chance of burns as a result of cigar ash.

This invention is also convenient for parties, gatherings and everyday use, in addition to in vehicles.
