At the same time it reduces the number of auto insurance claims that are filed. It is also easy to operate, safe and reliable. In addition, the simplicity of its concept and design minimizes production costs.

The inventor's personal experience inspired the idea. "When I've had to leave my car outside in the winter, I had difficulty keeping the ice and snow from accumulating around the wheels. I decided that using the heat from the car would be the best way to solve the problem," he said.
