Founded in 1984 in Pittsburgh, InventHelp is submitting this idea, the AUTO 1 to companies for their review.

PITTSBURGH, PA (<u>PRWEB</u>) November 10, 2016 -- "An acquaintance of mine lost a child and her business over a simple mistake by leaving a child in an unattended vehicle for six hours," said an inventor from Fort Worth, Texas. "I came up with this idea to ensure that this would never happen to anyone else."

She developed the AUTO 1 to alert the driver that a child remains in the vehicle. This ensures that the driver remembers to bring the child along when exiting the vehicle. It prevents a young child from being left in an unattended vehicle. This reduces the risk of injuries and/or death, which is designed to enhance personal safety. Additionally, the system is adaptable for use with any new or existing vehicle.
