Traffic Report for week of February 5, 2017

White Sands Missile Range Notification

I-10, Mile Marker 85 for Bridge Repairs, Deming CN 1101320

The New Mexico Department of Transportation and Hasse Contractors (Contractor) will be performing joint repair work. I-10 at MP 85 Bridge will have various lane closures for work on the bridge pier caps. Construction operation hours will be from 7:00 am to 6:00 pm, Monday through Friday. Please use caution in this area when workers are present.

<u>I-10, Mile Marker 91.7 to 94.5, Deming</u> (IN 1101250

The New Mexico Department of Transportation (NMDOT) along with La Calerita Construction (Contractor) will be performing bridge rehabilitation and roadway reconstruction operations to Interstate 10 (I-10) in Luna County; Construction is expected to be completed by summer 2017. Interstate traffic will encounter a detour while work is being performed and all interstate traffic is detoured off the westbound lane and will be sharing the eastbound lane, barrier wall is in use. An 11' width lane restriction is in effect. Motorists are asked to reduce speed, obey posted signs, and use extreme caution, and be cautious of personnel in the area.

I-10, Mile Marker 29, Lordsburg CN 1100611

The New Mexico Department of Transportation (NMDOT) along with James Hamilton Construction (Contractor) will be performing bridge repair work. Highway traffic will encounter intermittent lane closures as needed. Motorists are asked to reduce speed, obey posted signs, and use extreme caution, and be cautious of personnel in the area.

I-25 Mile Markers 51 to 75, Hatch

The New Mexico Department of Transportation and J-H Supply (Contractor) will be completing final cable barrier installation in the median. There will be moving lane closures on this project. Work is expected to last until end of February 2017. Motorists are asked to reduce speed, obey posted signs, and use extreme caution, and be cautious of personnel in the area.

I-25, Mile Marker 85.6 to 70 southbound, T or C

The NMDOT announces the following traffic alert information for Interstate 25, mile post 85.6 to mile post 70 southbound, performing fog sealing of roadway in Sierra County. The Speed limit will be reduced to 55 mph starting at 9:00 a.m. and will be lifted at 3:30p.m. daily, Monday through Friday. Traffic will encounter closures of the off and on ramps temporarily. Striping to be complete in

February, motorists are advised use caution and reduce speed while nearing and passing through the work zone being cautious of trucks turning and workers in the area.

US 70, Mile Markers 166.25 to 177.740, Las Cruces CN 1100570

The New Mexico Department of Transportation (NMDOT) along with Mountain States Contractors, Inc. (Contractor) will be performing roadway rehabilitation operations on US 70 in Dona Ana Co. Construction will begin Monday, January 30, 2017 and is expected to be completed by summer 2017. A 12' width lane restriction is in effect. Traffic will encounter lane drops at times with eastbound and westbound exits closed off to all traffic as needed. Motorists are asked to reduce speed, obey posted signs, and use extreme caution, and be cautious of personnel in the area. The closure will be in affect from 7:00 am to 5:00 pm.

US 380, Mile Marker 1 to 2.5, San Antonio

The New Mexico Department of Transportation and Hasse Contractors (Contractor) will be performing joint repair work starting February 13, 2017. US 380 from mile post 1 to mile post 2.5 and will have various shoulder closures for rip rap installation under the bridge. A 15' width lane restriction is in effect. Construction operation hours will be from 7:00 am to 6:00 pm, Monday through Friday. Please use caution in this area when workers are present.

NM 28, Mile Marker 19.5, San Miguel

The New Mexico Department of Transportation (NMDOT) along with AUI Inc. (Contractor) will begin work on a bridge replacement on NM 28 at milepost 19.5 (at Avenida Del Panteon). Construction is expected to last through February 2017. Traffic will encounter a pilot car operation while work is being performed. Motorists are asked to reduce speed, obey posted signs, and use extreme caution, and be cautious of personnel in the area.

NM 186, Mile Marker 0.7, Anthony

The New Mexico Department of Transportation (NMDOT) along with AUI Inc. (Contractor) will begin work on a bridge replacement on NM 186 at milepost 0.7 (W Ohara Rd). Construction at this location is expected to last through spring 2017. During this time period, NM 186 at this location will be completely CLOSED to traffic at all times. Through traffic along NM 186 is advised to be on alert and look for detour signs which will be posted throughout the area to guide traffic around the road closure.

NM 159, Mile Marker 8 to 10, Mogollon CN ER14103

The NMDOT along with La Calerita Construction, LLC, (Contractor) will perform Roadway & Drainage Improvements on NM 159 with expected completion fall of 2017. The only traffic that will be able to go through NM 159 will be the Mogollon residence and supplies for the Mogollon residence during the week. Construction operation hours will be from 7:00 am to 5:00 pm, Monday through Friday. Please use caution in this area when workers are present. NM 159 will be open for the weekend.

Las Cruces Projects – City of Las Cruces

Bex Court

From Bex Street to cul-de-sac will be closed to through traffic. Access to residents will be maintained at all times. Motorists will be asked to decrease speed through the construction zone and should proceed with caution.

Bex Street

From Farney Lane to Desert Rose Court will be closed to through traffic. Access to residents will be maintained at all times. Motorists will be asked to decrease speed through the construction zone and should proceed with caution.

Desert Rose Court

From Bex Street to cul-de-sac will be closed to through traffic. Access to residents will be maintained at all times. Motorists will be asked to decrease speed through the construction zone and should proceed with caution.

Farney Lane

From Main Street to Hixon Drive will be closed to through traffic. Access to residents will be maintained at all times. Motorists will be asked to decrease speed through the construction zone and should proceed with caution.

Farney Lane

From El Paseo Road to Espina Drive will be closed to through traffic. Access to residents will be maintained at all times. Motorists will be asked to decrease speed through the construction zone and should proceed with caution.

McGuffey Street

From Windridge Circle to Sirena Lane will be closed to through traffic. Detours are in place. Access to residents will be maintained at all times. Motorists will be asked to decrease speed through the construction zone and should proceed with caution.

Nemesh Drive

From Mohegan Trail to Mages Street will be closed to through traffic. Access to residents will be maintained at all times. Motorists will be asked to decrease speed through the construction zone and should proceed with caution.

Roadrunner Parkway

From Golf Club Road to Santo Domingo Avenue will have the inside north and south bound lanes closed to through traffic. Access to residents will be maintained at all times. Motorists will be asked to decrease speed through the construction zone and should proceed with caution.

Utah Avenue

From El Paseo Road to Mesquite Street will be closed to through traffic. Access to businesses will be detoured for full access. Motorists will be asked to decrease speed through the construction zone and should proceed with caution.

El Paso Projects – Go 10/Border West Expressway

I-10 @ Mesa

Continuous for 3 more weeks

The following closures started on Jan.18 and will continue until 4 p.m. on Friday, Feb. 24

- The right turn-only lane on eastbound North Mesa Street (SH 20) will close between Osborne Drive and South Desert Boulevard.
- The right through lane on eastbound North Mesa Street (SH 20) will close between Osborne Drive and South Desert Boulevard, but only when necessary and only during the day from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m.

Note: Two lanes will remain open on N. Mesa (SH 20) and business access will be open at all times.

Crews will be installing underground utilities.

Overnight

Monday, Feb. 6 through Thursday, Feb. 9

9 p.m. each night to 6 a.m. each morning

• I-10 in both directions will reduce to one lane at the North Mesa intersection overpass between Thorn Avenue and approximately 100 feet east of North Mesa Street (SH 20).

Crews will be moving dirt.

Overnight

Monday, Feb. 6 through Thursday, Feb. 9

9 p.m. each night to 6 a.m. each morning

- I-10 Eastbound will completely close at the North Mesa Exit Ramp (Exit 11).
- North Mesa Street (SH 20) at the I-10 Overpass will close in both directions for one-night during the four-night operation. The exact night is to be determined and will be announced 24 hours prior to the closing.

Detour: Motorists on I-10 East will exit at North Mesa Street (Exit 11), take Doniphan Drive to Sunland Park Drive, and will be able to re-enter I-10 from Sunland Park Drive.

NOTE: Keep to the detour route. Doniphan Drive does not provide access to I-10 nor to US 85 after Sunland Park Drive.

Crews will be placing bridge deck onto I-10 directly over North Mesa Street (SH 20).

I-10 @ Resler

Overnight

Monday, Feb. 6 through Thursday, Feb. 9

9 p.m. each night to 6 a.m. each morning

• The Resler Flyover Ramp to I-10 Eastbound will close.

Overnight

Wednesday, Feb. 8 and Thursday, Feb. 9

9 p.m. each night to 6 a.m. each morning

• I-10 Westbound will completely close after the Resler Exit Ramp (Exit 12).

Detour: Motorists on I-10 West will exit at Resler Drive (Exit 12) and take North Mesa Street (SH 20) westward to I-10 where they can re-enter I-10 West.

Crews will be working on the new Resler ramp structure.
