

Public Information Meeting Planned *Interstate 25 and Rio Bravo Proposed Interchange*

Nov. 16, 2016 (Albuquerque, NM)- The New Mexico Department of Transportation (NMDOT) and the Federal Highway Administration (FHWA) will hold a third public information meeting to discuss the proposed I-25/Rio Bravo Interchange Project.

Meeting Date and Time: Thursday, December 1, 6:00 PM – 8:00 PM

Meeting Location: Mountain View Community Center, 201 Prosperity Ave SE, 87105



The project limits include Rio Bravo Boulevard between Prince Street and University Boulevard and the I-25 highway between milepost 219.8 and milepost 221.4. The proposed project will reconstruct the interchange into a modernized facility capable of handling future traffic volumes and multimodal transportation demands.

The purpose of the meeting is to update the public on the progress of the project that is in the final design phase including important elements of the project design, anticipated construction schedule, and potential detours during construction. A presentation will be given with a public comment period to follow.
