PITTSBURGH, PA (PRWEB) April 13, 2017 -- An inventor from Star City, W.V., works in construction, so he's familiar with the inconvenience and damage caused by having to lean long pieces of wood and/or ladders across the edge of the exterior of a pickup-truck cab. "In order to prevent the unsightly and expensive dents and scratches, I came up with this idea," he said.

He then created a prototype of the CAB PROTECTOR, which allows for more convenient and safer hauling of long pieces of lumber and/or ladders via pickup truck. It prevents the cab exterior from becoming scratched and dented, which avoids unsightliness and the need for expensive repairs.
