He developed COMMUNICATOR to provide motorists with a hands-free way to read text and emails while driving, thus eliminating the need for a driver to use a smartphone to receive text messages. In other words, it enhances driver safety by reducing the risk of a distraction-related accident. As a result, it has the potential to save lives and reduce chances of injuries and property damage from automobile accidents. At the same time, it is lightweight, compact and portable. This versatile invention is also reliable and easy to install and use. In addition, it is convenient, effective and affordably priced.

The inventor's personal observation inspired the idea. "I was concerned about the incidence of motor vehicle accidents in which texting was a factor, so I devised a safe way for drivers to receive important messages," he said.
