It prevents loads from sliding or falling, which avoids damage, hassle and inefficiency. It also eliminates the need for garage storage, unsightly hardware and the need to open the tailgate.

Compatible with all compact and full-size pickup trucks, the IDEAL RACK is durable, space-saving, versatile and easy to install/use, and it's ideal for DIYers, construction workers and other contractors.
