He developed a prototype for the patent-pending UNDER CAR SPRINKLER to simplify cleaning of the undercarriage of a motor vehicle with little time and effort. As such, it reduces the potential for costly wear, damage and corrosion development and eliminates expensive vehicle repairs and replacement. Easy to maneuver on hard surfaces, this innovation is lightweight, portable and user friendly. Other appealing features include convenience, effectiveness and an affordable price. In addition, the simple design of this invention minimizes production costs.

The inventor's experience in public works inspired the idea. "We needed a way to remove the large deposits of salt clinging to the underside of our plow trucks and decided this idea was the answer," he said.
