

InventHelp Inventor Develops Enhanced Automotive Sun Shade (AVZ-1615)

InventHelp, founded in 1984 in Pittsburgh, is attempting to submit this idea, the WINDOW SPIDER to applicable companies for their consideration.

PITTSBURGH (PRWEB) December 18, 2017 -- "Conventional sun visors used to keep sunlight from heating up the vehicle interior are a pain to put up and take down," said an inventor from Reno, Nev. "In order to simplify the process, I came up with an alternative way to shield the vehicle interior from sunlight."

He developed the WINDOW SPIDER to protect the vehicle interior from sunlight. This keeps the cabin at a cool and comfortable temperature when the vehicle is parked outdoors on a hot day. It also safeguards upholstery and interior from harmful UV rays. The unit adjusts to fit the exact size of the windshield, which makes it adaptable for use in any new or existing vehicle. Additionally, the unit features a compact, easily portable design.
