They developed the CASEY SYSTEM to prevent a child or pet from being left in a vehicle unattended. The system automatically reminds adults to return to the vehicle in the event that a child or pet is forgotten. It reduces the risk of hypothermia and hyperthermia, which is designed to enhance personal safety. The system thereby offers added peace of mind to parents and caregivers. Furthermore, it is adaptable for use with both new and existing vehicles. Also, it notifies emergency services and provides GPS location.
