### Bridge and Roadway Maintenance Work Scheduled

**Albuquerque, NM** – The New Mexico Department of Transportation announced that work will commence this weekend and week to perform maintenance work at the following locations:

### Paseo Del Norte westbound September 8th through September 11th

- \*No Work/Lane Restrictions over Labor Day Weekend
- NM 423 (Paseo Del Norte) westbound between 2<sup>nd</sup> Street and NM 45 (Coors Blvd) on the Rio Grande Bridge will have a continues double left lane and shoulder restrictions.
- Work is weather dependent and subject to change.

## I-25 southbound September 22<sup>nd</sup> through September 25<sup>th</sup>

- \*No Work/Lane Restrictions over Labor Day Weekend
- \*No Work/Lane Restrictions during the State Fair
- I-25 southbound between milepost 224 (Lead Ave) and milepost 226 (Indian School Rd) will have continues right lane restrictions
- I-40 westbound to I-25 southbound flyover ramp will have a left lane restriction.
- I-40 eastbound to I-25 southbound flyover ramp CLOSED
- Work is weather dependent and subject to change.

### I-25, NM 500 (Rio Bravo), and NM 47 (Broadway Blvd) Phase 1 through September 9<sup>th</sup>

- AUI will be working nights, from 9 p.m. each evening to 5 a.m. the next morning, on I-25 to mill and install asphalt to prepare for the upcoming traffic switch to Phase I. Northbound I-25 from about 4,000 feet south of the I-25/Rio Bravo Interchange to the Interchange – Will be reduced to one lane on the righthand side closest to the shoulder during the first part of the week, starting on Tuesday, Sept. 5.Southbound I-25 from the I-25/Rio Bravo Interchange to about 4,000 feet south of the Interchange – Will be reduced to one lane on the righthand side closest to the shoulder to one lane on the righthand side closest to the shoulder during the first part of the week, starting on Tuesday, Sept. 5.Southbound I-25 from the I-25/Rio Bravo Interchange to about 4,000 feet south of the Interchange – Will be reduced to one lane on the righthand side closest to the shoulder in the latter of the part of the week.
