Pavement Rehabilitation Work U.S. 70 Lincoln County

Hondo – The New Mexico Department of Transportation (NMDOT) District Two will begin a project to rehabilitate 17-miles of pavement on U.S. 70 in Lincoln County.

The work will begin this summer on U.S. 70 at the junction of U.S. 380 east to Riverside in the Hondo Valley. The \$7.5 million project will take approximately 6 months to complete, weather permitting.

During the project motorists can expect short delays between the hours of 7:00 a.m. and 5:00 p.m., Monday through Friday. Motorists are asked to watch for construction personnel working in the area, observe temporary lane closures, and reduce speed while work is taking place. Remember to please drive safely through work zones.
