N.M. 48 Bridge Work Begins In Lincoln County

Lincoln County – The New Mexico Department of Transportation (NMDOT) will invest \$2 million to replace the N.M. 48 bridge at mile marker 17 near Capitan.

The work will replace the existing bridge with a new structure, ensuring proper flow of the waterway and stabilizing the N.M. 48 road surface above.

A temporary crossing will be constructed, as well as, new guardrail, permanent signing and striping, traffic control and other miscellaneous construction. Motorists can expect short delays while work is taking place. Work is expected to take 6 months to complete, weather permitting.

Remember to drive safely through work zones.
