State Transportation Commission Meeting in Ruidoso Opportunity for Public Comment

RUIDOSO – The New Mexico Department of Transportation holds six public Commission Meetings each year. The forth meeting for 2019 will be held in Ruidoso on Thursday, August 15th at 8:30 a.m. at the Village Council Chambers. It is located at 313 Cree Meadows Drive.

The six member governor-appointed Commission determines policy for the New Mexico Department of Transportation. NMDOT divides the state into six districts. There is one Commissioner appointed to represent each district. Currently, there is a vacant seat for District Five which covers San Juan, Rio Arriba, Santa Fe and Torrance Counties.
