N.M. 532 (Ski Run Road) Safety Improvement Project Begins in Lincoln County

Road Will Remain Open During Safety Improvement Work

Ruidoso, N.M. – The New Mexico Department of Transportation (NMDOT) will begin a safety improvement project on N.M. 532 (Ski Run Road) in Lincoln County this month. The \$3.5 million project is expected to take a year to complete. The safety project will take place near mile marker 7, known as the Texas Curve on Ski Run Road.

Ski Run Road will remain open during this work, with the exception of occasional single lane closures for the safety of motorists. Flagging operations will be in effect. Work will take place adjacent to the highway while crews build the new wider safer road for motorists. Work will also include slope stabilization, earthwork, rock excavation, guardrail replacement, and other miscellaneous construction.

This project is part of the continuing work over the past several years to improve safety along N.M. 532 (Ski Run Road).
