Construction Begins on Bridge Replacement Project in Los Lunas Project Expected to Last Through Spring 2021

LOS LUNAS, NM— Construction has begun on a project to replace the Main Street Bridge crossing the Rio Grande in Los Lunas. FNF is the contractor for the project, which will also include utility improvements, ADA ramps and erosion control for the project area.

Motorists should expect lane closures beginning in late December. At that time, eastbound and westbound traffic will be merged into a single lane in each direction from Calle de Wences to Edeal Road. Additional construction phases and traffic impacts will follow.

Regular work hours for the project are Monday-Friday 7 a.m.-5 p.m. The project is expected to take about 15-16 months, with completion scheduled in spring 2021.

Motorists are encouraged to seek alternate routes if possible, to obey posted speed limits in the construction zone and to give themselves extra time to reach their destinations. For updated construction information, visit www.nmroads.com.
