Construction Barricading to Change Week of January 6, 2020 On Main Street Bridge Replacement Project in Los Lunas

Project Expected to Last Through Spring 2021

LOS LUNAS, **1-2-20** – Construction is continuing on the project to replace the Main Street Bridge crossing the Rio Grande in Los Lunas, with barricading expected to change the first full week of January 2020.

Beginning the week of Jan. 6-10, 2020, westbound traffic on NM 6 (Main Street) will be reduced to one lane between Carson Drive and Edeal Road. Motorists should expect delays and give themselves extra time to reach their destinations. This phase of construction is expected to last through mid to late February with occasional changes in traffic barricading.

FNF is the contractor for the project. Regular work hours are Monday-Friday 7 a.m.-5 p.m. In addition to bridge replacement, the project also includes utility improvements, ADA ramps and erosion control for area.

The project is expected to take about 15-16 months, with completion scheduled in spring 2021.
