Different from other digital ride share services, Ride N Care is simple to operate, whether or not the user has a smart phone. Also, drivers are specially trained to assist with seniors and those recovering from a hospital stay. Transportation requests are simply completed either by speaking to an operator available 24/7 or through the digital interface that allows individuals and health care organizations to easily manage transportation type selection, pricing, scheduling, pick up and drop off, and payment processing.

“We are delighted to partner alongside St. Joseph Health to deliver improved patient outcomes with a simple, reliable, and essential transportation solution,” says Danilo Toskovic, Ride N Care's co-founder and CEO. “Ride N Care's health and wellness transportation service fits well with St. Joseph Health's continuum of care and need to deliver personalized patient transportation in a simple, flexible, and cost-efficient program.”

With this new partnership, St. Joseph Health will pilot Ride N Care at St. Joseph Hospital in Orange, Calif. and St. Mary Medical Center in Apple Valley, Calif. Case managers will use the Ride N Care transportation platform to price, coordinate and schedule rides for inpatient discharge and outpatient post-procedure transportation on a 24/7 basis.

Patient eligibility for the pilot will be determined by St. Joseph Health caregivers. Ride N Care will also be available on a direct-pay basis to all other individuals at the two hospitals. The pilot is slated to begin in late May 2017.
