Additionally, when the 2021 Venue is on the road, it will make 121 horsepower while also posting Environmental Protection Agency fuel economy scores of 30 miles per gallon or higher in the city or on the highway.

When the completely redesigned Tucson arrives at the dealership's showroom, it will be available with a wide range of new powertrains, including hybrid and plug-in hybrid options.
