NM 6 to Be Restricted to one lane in each direction Thursday evening, September 3 for addition of utilities

Construction Continuing with Project Expected to Last Through Spring 2021

LOS LUNAS-Crews are scheduled to restrict NM 6 (the Main Street Bridge) crossing the Rio Grande to one lane in each direction from 8 p.m. Thursday, September 3 through 5:30 a.m. Friday, Sept. 4, 2020.

The lane restrictions are needed so that crews can add new utilities across NM 6.

Construction began on the project to replace the Main Street Bridge crossing the Rio Grande in Los Lunas in November 2019 and is expected to continue through spring of 2021.

FNF is the contractor for the project. Regular work hours are Monday-Friday 7 a.m.-5 p.m., although the contractor may work evenings or weekends as needed.

In addition to bridge replacement, the project also includes utility improvements, ADA ramps and erosion control for the area.
