Both model years of both Toyota crossover SUVs are universally equipped with a smartphone-compatible infotainment system that will have access to the Android AutoTM and Apple CarPlay® suites of applications. The 2021 RAV4 and 2021 Highlander are also available with a high-speed Wi-Fi hotspot.
