

MV Transportation Donates \$100K in Water to Support Texas Winter Storm Recovery

Donation includes three semi-trailer loads of bottled water to be distributed to employees and community partners serving those who remain in need across the state

While much of the state's water issues have now been restored, many communities and apartment complexes are still without water.

Public and private relief organizations stepped up to help those in need, including Texas Baptist Men, whose water supplies have now been depleted due to the crisis. MV's donation, comprised of three semi-trailer loads of over 4,000 cases of bottled water, will provide further aid to those still in need and boost much needed supplies.

"Since its founding in 1975, MV has maintained a strong culture for supporting the communities we serve," said Tom Egan, MV CEO. "While that support usually involves providing safe and reliable transportation for individuals to their jobs, school, grocery store, or important medical appointments, it is a natural extension of our mission to support those in need today due to the recent storms and our community partners that are on the front line providing assistance."
