Sidewalk upgrades begin March 1 on N.M. 48 (Sudderth Drive) in Ruidoso

RUIDOSO – The New Mexico Department of Transportation (NMDOT) District Two and the Village of Ruidoso are investing nearly \$500,000 in a sidewalk replacement project to improve safety and pedestrian access. Construction will take place in mid-town Ruidoso on Sudderth Drive (N.M. 48) beginning March 1.

NMDOT and the Village will work closely with local businesses while work is taking place to always ensure business access. Drivers can expect periodic, single lane closures. Weather permitting, work is expected to be completed this summer.
