Opponents Nativo Lopez and Xavier Reyes appear on the program with Mountjoy are leading the battle statewide against the Referendum, appealing to the immigrant Latino community.

Senator Richard Mountjoy (ret.) & Nativo Lopez, President MAPA debate the Referendum to Repeal the 2003 California Drivers License Law (SB60) which pemits illegal aliens to obtain driver's licenses) and the lack of security in the new law. Mountjoy argues that the referendum is important because the new law neglects including fingerprints and background checks in issuing the new licenses, which could allow illegal aliens to vote and purchase firearms.

Senator Richard Mountjoy (ret.) & Xavier Reyes, Director of Communications & Education, CHIRLA discuss the effects of the 2003 California Drivers License Law to offer driver's licenses to illegal aliens and the costs due to fact that the majority of illegal aliens fall into the category of uninsured motorists and debate whether the referendum to Repeal should go forward.
