My Air Hitch replaced the roller bearings inside the <u>trailer hitch</u>, which often wear out the metal, become loose, or distort the track, with nylon tubing designed by engineers in the aerospace industry. This makes the air-ride <u>trailer hitch</u> act like a shock absorber, taking in all the jerking and pulling that is normally experienced by the truck and trailer. The nylon tubing is maintenance-free, while roller bearing hitches must be serviced every 10,000 miles.

 $\hat{A} \Box$ Our fabricators use the computer-controlled plasma arc cutter, shears, and brakes to form our metal. This is a stronger, safer method of manufacturing and eliminates a lot of cutting and welding, $\hat{A} \Box$ said Shelli Taylor. $\hat{A} \Box$ The plasma cutter puts less heat into the part, which means less warpage than traditional flame cutters. The plasma arc cutter also cuts five times faster than flame cutters, which allows us to cut delivery time and cost, and produces a much cleaner piece of metal. The quality is much better than a traditional flame cut piece. $\hat{A} \Box$
