“This will be the biggest buyers lot in Ohio for those three days,” said Leon Meyer, GXNPS2 Gamers Club member. It will be an ideal place to sell, and great opportunity for buyers to shop many vehicles in one location.

This will be the first event of this type for the club, but not the last. Plans are already in place for a similar event to raise money for children of service members each year.

“We plan to use the proceeds to buy toys and bicycles for the kids. We want to help them because their parents are putting their lives on the line for us, and we know that financially it is tough for military family, especially around the holidays that are coming up,” explained Meyer.

Those who wish to register to sell at the auto swap meet should call 937-268-6218 as soon as possible to reserve space. Cars can be displayed for just \$65 for the three day event and vendors can reserve a 15 ft. x 15 ft. booth space for only \$250. Admission is \$15 for a one day pass, or \$35 for all three days.

A Ford F-250 will be given away as one of the many door prizes for the weekend.
