## Construction on the Main Street Bridge in Los Lunas nears completion

Final phase includes lane shifts in each direction on NM 6, March 29-April 3

LOS LUNAS- Paving and striping are all that remain to complete the NM 6 Main Street Bridge crossing over the Rio Grande. One lane will be open both east and westbound beginning Monday, March 29 through Sunday, April 3, 2021.

The lane restrictions will initially shift traffic to the south in the construction area, with one lane open in each direction (east and west). Lane shifts and restrictions will change in order for crews to complete paving and striping on both sides of the road.

Motorists using NM 6 should expect delays during this time and use extra caution in the construction area.

Construction began on the Main Street Bridge replacement project in November 2019 and is expected to be completed in April 2021.

FNF is the contractor for the project. Regular work hours are Monday-Friday 7 a.m.-6 p.m., although the contractor may work evenings or weekends as needed.

In addition to bridge replacement, the project includes utility improvements, ADA ramps and erosion control for the area.
