

## **Sunday August 28: Hundreds to Gather in Cutler Bay to Protest BDS and Express Solidarity with Israel**

*The grassroots group Miami United Against BDS (MUAB) is inviting the media and the general public to attend its “Let’s Defeat BDS” rally this Sunday (Aug.28). Joined by the motorcades of Rolling Thunder, Florida Loubarvitchs and Jewish European Organization (OJE), hundreds of American supporters of Israel will be coming together as a community to express opposition to BDS and solidarity with the allies of Israel.*
