"Everyone wants to be as far away from a crash as possible," says inventor Malinda R. "Not everyone is six feet tall and shorter people have to move their seat forward in order to operate a motor vehicle. This device offers added protection from the airbag itself in that at the point of impact, it sends the seat backward to the full extent, putting more space between the airbag and the driver and moving them a little further from a crash impact also."

The Enhanced Airbag System is a new car safety invention designed to mitigate the negative results of a deployed air bag.
