The 2021 Nissan Rogue is available in four trim levels which include the S, SV, SL and Platinum. All trim levels are available with either front-wheel drive or all-wheel drive. The standard engine in all of the trim levels is a 2.5-liter DOHC Direct Injection 4-cylinder engine that produces 181 horsepower and 181 pound-foot of torque.

There are a variety of driver-assist technologies available in the 2021 Nissan Rogue. Some of these include Intelligent Forward Collision Warning, Automatic Emergency Braking with Pedestrian Detection, Lane Departure Warning, Blind Spot Warning, Rear Cross Traffic Alert and a RearView Monitor. These are standard on the base trim level and there are even more available on the higher trim levels.

For a crossover, the 2021 Nissan Rogue has an impressive estimated fuel economy. The number of miles are slightly different on the different trim levels, but the crossover gets approximately 27 miles per gallon in the city, 35 miles per gallon on the highway and 30 miles per gallon combined.
