"After Grand Bend, there are only three more chances to get in – the St Thomas Raceway Park double in August and the Saturday of Labor Day weekend at Cayuga Dragway."

Gates open at 9am on Friday with TNTSS qualifying sessions set for 4pm and 5pm - eliminations at 6pm.
