## Industry News

The Nuremburg Toy Fair was Feb 1-6. Tamiya made some kit announcements. They will release a 1/24 kit of the TOMs Lexus SC430 (below) from the Japan Super GT series, kit 24293. A detail set will also be released. Also, the 1/12 Ferrari 312T and 312T4 will be reissued, with P/E parts. The 1/20 Lotus 99T Honda will be reissued. Two 1/12 versions of the 2006 RC211V Honda racing motorcycle are coming out along with a detail fork set.



Revell Europe has announced a kit in 1/24 of the Audi R10 TDI, the 2006 LeMans winner, kit #07248, it is on their website.



Also an Audi R8 street car in 1/24.



There are reports that AMT is for sale. Parent corporation RC2 feels it is not profitable, stayed tuned for further news.

## Events

The Ferrari Expo on March 17 at Continental Motorsports in Hinsdale will again host a model car show this year. Last year was the first year, this year the event should be bigger. As part of their annual Ferrari and Italian sports car enthusiasts' event, the models in the contest are limited to sports and formula racing cars, also exotic sports cars and imports, since this is the interest of the event promoters. This year racing (FIA style) motorcycles will also be included, as well as a photo contest (8x10) of these subjects. GTR will have a table, we have been asked to provide some volunteers to help out with supporting the show, let me know if you are interested. Besides the model show, there is a swap meet of models along with road racing and Italian sports car memorabilia. And it is held in a Ferrari and Maserati dealership, so the real cars in the showroom and outside are great, too.

The 8th Classic Plastic event hosted by Rockford wheels in Scale and originally scheduled for Sunday, January 28, has been rescheduled to March 18. There was a scheduling issue with the site, and they were forced to reschedule. It will be at the same location, the Ken Rock Community Center in Rockford, on Sunday, March 18. The contest theme is Famous Automobiles, movie, TV or famous person's automobiles.

So that weekend looks to be a busy one for GTR guys as we will have a presence at both shows our regular meeting for March is on the 17<sup>th</sup> as well.

There will be a 3<sup>rd</sup> annual Plastic Summer Meltdown event. Hosted by CARS in Miniature, whose members voted to approve the show, the final date and details are still being worked on.

The IPMS USA National Convention moves across the country to a new site each year. The 2009 Convention was due to be held in the central part of the country, but since there were no official bids received by the January 1 deadline any chapter in any region can now bid on it. I thought that there was some interest from a Minneapolis chapter, but now we will wait until this year's convention in Anaheim in August to find out where it will be.

Copies of all these will be available for viewing at the next meeting.

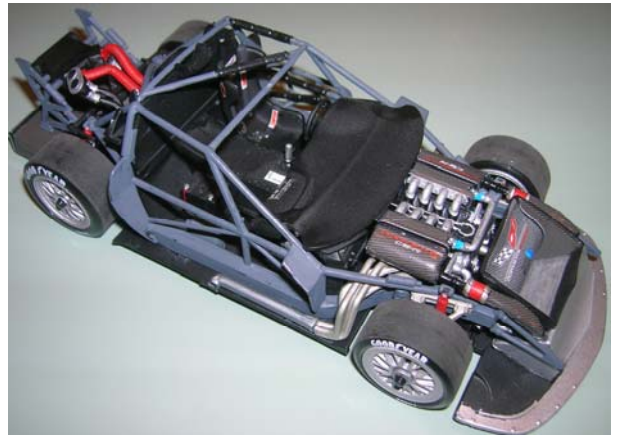
## January GTR Meeting

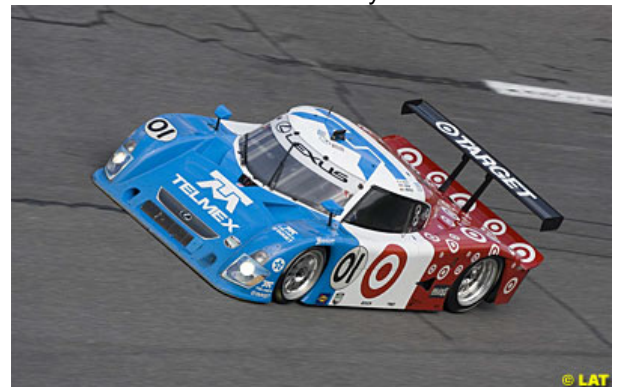
