NHTSA Recall 12V-222

IMPORTANT SAFETY RECALL NOTICE

Dear Honda Accord Owner:

This notice is sent to you in accordance with the requirements of the National Traffic and Motor Vehicle Safety Act.

What is the reason for this notice?

Honda has decided that a defect which relates to motor vehicle safety exists in certain 2003-2007 model year Accord V6 vehicles. Prolonged high under-hood temperatures and high power steering fluid temperatures may cause the power steering hose to deteriorate prematurely and may cause the hose to crack and leak power steering fluid. Fluid leaking onto a hot catalytic converter will generate smoke, a burning smell and possibly lead to an under-hood fire.

What should you do?

Parts to complete the repair will begin to arrive at dealerships in early 2013. Honda will send you another letter when parts are available to repair your vehicle.

What to do if you feel this notice is in error.

Registration records indicate that you are the current owner or lessee of a 2003-2007 Honda Accord V6 involved in this campaign. We will then update our records.

Lessor Information.

Federal law requires that any vehicle lessor receiving this recall notice must forward a copy of this notice to the lessee within 10 days.
