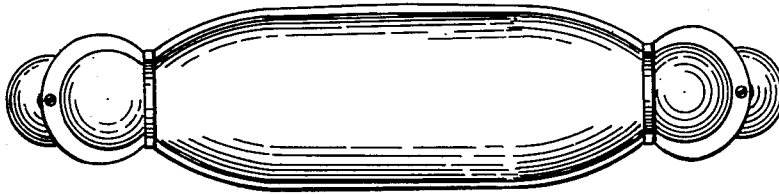

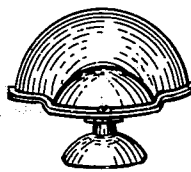

## DESIGN FOR AN ILLUMINABLE SIGN FOR MOTOR VEHICLES

*To all whom it may concern:*

Be it known that I, Walter H. Brandes, a citizen of the Dominion of Canada and a resident of the city of Toronto, county of York, Province of Ontario, Dominion of Canada, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for an Illuminable Sign for Motor Vehicles, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawings, forming part thereof.
