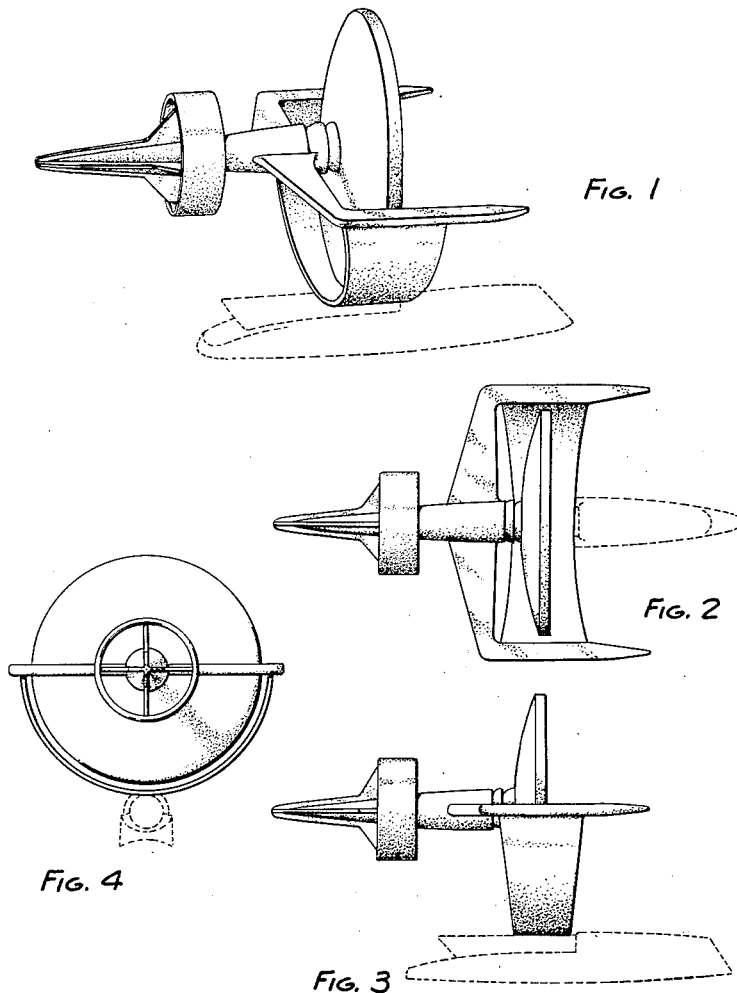


Fig. 1 is a perspective view of an automobile rear view mirror or similar article embodying my new design.
