NOTICE OF RECENT AMENDMENTS TO RI REGULATIONS AND CHANGES IN REQUIREMENTS FOR MAINTENANCE OF RI REGISTRATION

NHTSA recently issued a final rule amending the agency's regulations pertaining to registered importers (RIs). The final rule was published in the Federal Register on August 25, 2011 at 78 FR 53072-53080. A copy of the final rule is attached. As stated in that document, the amendments were made to enable the agency to deny applications for registration from entities whose principals or associates have been convicted of a crime related to the importation, purchase, or sale of a motor vehicle or motor vehicle equipment and to revoke existing registrations held by such entities. Another amendment requires an RI to certify that it destroyed or exported nonconforming motor vehicle equipment removed from a vehicle during conformance modifications. The final rule also establishes new requirements for motor vehicles imported for the purpose of preparing an import eligibility petition, adopts a clearer definition of the term "model year" for import eligibility purposes, and requires import eligibility petitions to include the type classification and gross vehicle weight rating (GVWR) of the vehicle it covers.

The regulations, as amended, now specify that to maintain its registration, an RI must "[n]ot be convicted of, or have any person associated with direct or indirect ownership or control of the registered importer's business or any person employed by or associated with the registered importer who is convicted of, a crime related to the importation, purchase, or sale of motor vehicles or motor vehicle equipment." The regulations specify that "[t]hese offenses include, but are not limited to, title fraud, odometer fraud, or the sale of stolen vehicles." See 49 CFR 592.5(f)(1).

The regulations (49 CFR 592.5(f)(2)) also require existing RIs seeking to renew their registrations to file an annual statement that includes the following recitals:

"I certify that I have read and understand the duties of a Registered Importer, as set forth in 49 CFR 592.6, and that [name of Registered Importer] continues to comply with the requirements for being a Registered Importer."

"I certify that all information provided in each of my previous annual statements, submitted pursuant to § 592.6(q), or changed in any notification that [name of Registered Importer] may have provided to the Administrator in compliance with § 592.6(I), remains correct and that all the information provided in this annual statement is true and correct."

"I certify that I understand that, in the event that its registration is suspended or revoked, or lapses, [name of Registered Importer] will remain obligated to notify owners and to remedy noncompliance issues or safety related defects, as required by 49 CFR 592.6(j), for each vehicle for which [name of Registered Importer] has furnished a certificate of conformity to the Administrator."

As a result of these amendments, you must submit a revised annual statement to continue to be a registered importer for fiscal year (FY) 2012, which begins on October 1, 2011. The information specified below should be submitted as soon as possible, but no later than September 30, 2011, for your company to remain in active status as an RI. Failure to submit the renewal information by that date will cause your registration to be automatically suspended effective October 11, 2011, as provided in 49 CFR 592.7(a)(1).

If there are no changes to your RI business information, please submit your yearly statement as shown on the sample renewal on Page 3 of this newsletter. Don't forget to mail with your renewal the two required enclosures: a new service insurance policy (with notarized signatures) and your credit card authorization or a check made payable to the Treasurer of the United States in the amount of \$670.

SAMPLE YEARLY STATEMENT OF REGISTERED IMPORTER - WITH CHANGES

If your RI business information has changed since last year's renewal, please submit your yearly statement as shown on the sample renewal on Page 4-8 of this newsletter. Again, don't forget to mail with your renewal the three required enclosures: Application for Registration as Importer, a new service insurance policy (with notarized signatures), and your credit card authorization or a check made payable to the Treasurer of the United States in the amount of \$670.

Please disregard the information you were furnished in Registered Importer Newsletter No. 41 dated August 23, 2011 concerning the maintenance of your RI registration. If you have already submitted an annual statement in response to that newsletter, you will need to submit a new statement, meeting the requirements specified above. If you have already submitted an authorization or a check to cover the annual renewal fee, there is no need for you to send an additional authorization or check.

	1	Registration as Importer (Registered Importer)" A narrated digital DVD video that shows the facilities the applicant proposes to use to conduct its business as an RI. This must be formatted to play in Windows Media Player® or in QuickTime®. Suitable video formats include MPEG® and AVI. The recording must include footage of the office space and office equipment the applicant will use in its RI business, including file cabinets or other devices that will be used to store the records an RI must maintain. The recording must also show the area outside the building as having secure vehicle storage space and the premises inside the building that will be used for performing conformance modifications on imported nonconforming vehicles. Footage must also be provided that shows that the applicant has procured a current copy of Title 49, Code of Federal Regulations, Parts 400 to 599. (§ 592.5(a)(9)(ii))
	2	If the applicant is a non-public corporation, the applicant must provide a statement issued by the Office of the Secretary of State, or other responsible official of the State in which the applicant is incorporated, certifying that the applicant is a corporation in good standing. The application also must include the full name, street address, and date of birth of each officer, director, manager, and person who is authorized to sign documents on behalf of the corporation and the name of any person who owns or controls 10% or more of the corporation. (§ 592.5(a)(9)(iii))
	12	Information sufficient to establish that the applicant is able to acquire and maintain information regarding the vehicles that it imports and the names and addresses of the vehicles that it imports or for which it furnishes certificates of conformity to NHTSA in order to notify such owners when a noncompliance or a defect related to motor vehicle safety has been determined to exist in such vehicles.
