Nighttime Closures Necessary to Repair Wall Barrier Damaged in Auto Accident as well as Continue Construction on Headline Boulevard Expansion


**ALBUQUERQUE** —Project officials announced today announced a number of closures in the Paseo Del Norte/I-25 Interchange area needed for repairs as well as for continuation of work on the Headline Boulevard Expansion.

- From 9 p.m.-6 a.m. Monday, Feb. 16 and Monday, Feb. 23, crews will close the northbound I-25 off-ramp to Paseo Del Norte (see map to right);
- 2) From 7 p.m.-6 a.m. Monday, Feb. 16 and Monday, Feb. 23, the I-25 northbound frontage road will be closed at Pino.

Motorists can use Del Rey to San Francisco to San Pedro to Alameda as a detour (see map to right). Upon re-opening on Tuesday, Feb. 17 and through Monday, Feb. 23, the I-25 frontage road at Pino will have the left lane closed (see map to left). These closures are necessary to repair wall barrier that was

3) Beginning at **6 a.m. Feb. 17 and lasting through 6 a.m. Feb. 24**, crews will close the right lane of the southbound I-25 frontage road to remove wall barrier and replace curbing (see map below) in order to make modifications for future access to this area.

- 4) Beginning at 6 a.m. Wednesday, Feb. 18, and lasting through approximately 6 a.m. Wednesday, Feb. 24, there will be daytime closures of the northbound right lane on Jefferson near Headline between 9 a.m.-3 p.m. as part of the Headline Boulevard Expansion.
- 5) Also planned to begin next **Monday**, **Feb. 23** for approximately one week, through **Monday**, **March 2**, **c**rews will close the southbound right lane of Jefferson near Headline as part of the Headline Boulevard Expansion project.

Construction on the Headline Boulevard Expansion is scheduled to be completed by June 2015. All construction is subject to change without notice and weather permitting.
