Available with a 2.7-liter EcoBoost engine and LED lighting, the 2017 model is noteworthy for a variety of new features. The hybrid version gets over 40 miles per gallon.

The car successfully avoided collisions in IIHS track test at 12 and 25 mph. In order to secure the <u>IIHS Top Safety Pick award</u>, a model needs to earn good ratings in all types of crashworthiness testing, and the front crash prevention system must also earn an advanced or superior rating. Forward collision warning features are also available for the 2017 model. In addition to the IIHS, the National Highway Traffic Safety Administration has also recognized the exceptional standards of safety met by this mid-size sedan.
