

Inventor and InventHelp Client Develops Motorcycle/ATV Accessory (WDH-797)

Pittsburgh-based InventHelp is submitting this idea, the WILLY LIGHT, to companies for their consideration.

PITTSBURGH, PA (PRWEB) December 05, 2015 -- "I love motorcycles, ATVs and gaming. The combination of all these elements means that I love doing tricks and coming up with new ways to do things," said an inventor from Hyattsville, Md. "I came up with this idea so that I could see where I am going when doing a wheelie at night."

He developed the WILLY LIGHT to illuminate the path in front of the motorcycle or ATV while the rider is performing a wheelie. This ensures that the rider can direct the vehicle straight ahead, which enables him or her to avoid obstacles and potential dangers. The unit also illuminates the roadway in dark or dimly lit areas. It adds a stylish touch when doing wheelies at night. Furthermore, the device is adaptable for use with any motorcycle or ATV.
