This enables motorists to clear a path for the emergency vehicle. The main benefit of the system is that it reduces the risk of collisions, which is designed to enhance roadway safety. Additionally, the invention is adaptable for use with new and existing vehicles.

Also, it can be used by funeral processions, stopping traffic in all directions until the procession has passed.
